PETALING JAYA: Grassroots football development in Malaysia will get a boost as the Real Madrid Foundation Educational Football Programme is set to commence in Kuala Lumpur.

The year-round educational programme, scheduled to kick off in October, will combine teaching sportsrelated values through football.
